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Launch of the Application Management System

EFFECTIVE DATE: IMMEDIATELY

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is advising industry the new Application Management System (AMS) is now online. Most oil and gas applications in British Columbia will now be submitted through AMS. You can find AMS on the online services webpage [here](#).

In order to access AMS, security roles need to be assigned. There are two roles in the new system for submitting applications and for spatial access: *Applications* and *Application Analysis Tool Access*. A description of the security roles and how to assign them can be found in [INDB 2016-18](#).
