## Order:

Pursuant to section 50(1)(a) of the Oil and Gas Activities Act (the Act), I, Lance Ollenberger, order that Predator Oil BC Ltd. (Predator) must:

1. Cease all activities associated with Item 1 of General Order 2017-090 (the Order) at the frac water storage site located at D-024-G/094-P-10 (the Site).

## Conditions:

A. This order shall remain in effect until amended or terminated in whole or in part by the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission).

## Reasons:

I make this order for the following reasons:
i. Predator is the permit holder of the Site.
ii. On July 14, 2017, the Commission issued the Order to Predator.
iii. Predator has failed to comply with Item 1 of the Order.
iv. As set out in the letter from the Commission dated October 2, 2018, the Commission intends to carry out the work identified in item 1 of the Order pursuant to section 50(1)(b) of the Act.
v. I am of the view that this Order is necessary to allow the Commission to complete the work safely and efficiently.
