Order:

Pursuant to section 50(1)(a) of the Oil and Gas Activities Act, I, Ken Paulson, order that Predator Oil BC Ltd. (Predator) must:

1. Cease all activities associated with item a) of General Order 2018-018 (the order) at sites listed in Schedule A of the order (the sites).

Conditions:

- A. This order shall remain in effect until amended or terminated in whole or in part by the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission).

Reasons:

I make this order for the following reasons:

- i. Predator is the permit holder for the sites.
- ii. On September 26th, 2018, the Commission issued the order to Predator.
- iii. Predator has failed to comply with item a) of the order.
- iv. As set out in the letter dated July 5th, 2019, the Commission intends to carry out the work identified in item a) of the order pursuant to section 50(1)(b) of the Act.
- v. I am of the view that this order is necessary to allow the Commission to complete the work safely and efficiently.

Review and Appeal:
