**RE: PRESSURE MAINTENANCE WATERFLOOD
SPECIAL PROJECT CANCELLATION
CRUSH FIELD – HALFWAY “B” POOL UNIT #1**

The waterflood project in the Crush field, Halfway ‘B’ pool, Unit #1, was approved on September 11, 1970. Commission records for the project indicate that production from the wells in the pool and unit ceased October 1995 and that no water injection has occurred. Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. (CNRL) has reviewed the project and concurs that cancellation of the pressure maintenance waterflood approval is appropriate.

Pursuant to the *Oil and Gas Activities Act (OGAA)* section 75(2)(b), the Commission may cancel, suspend or amend a designation (iii) if the Commission considers that the designation is spent, or (iv) if the Commission considers that the designation is no longer appropriate, including, without limitation, for reasons of (a) public safety, (b) protection of the environment, or (c) conservation of petroleum and natural gas resources.

The Special Project Approval for the Crush field, Halfway “B” Pool, Unit #1, is here by cancelled under section 75(2)(b)(iii) of *OGAA*; the Commission considers that the designation is spent.
