Updated Wells Application Manual and Form

TO: Industry Clients

EFFECTIVE DATE: June 28, 2010

BACKGROUND:

As per inline testing Directive 2010-03 released April 8, 2010 inline testing has been made mandatory for all new wells located within 1.25 km of a residence and 3.0 km or less from pipeline infrastructure. The Wells and Test Holes Manual (Manual) and Well / Test Hole Application Form (Form) have been updated to reflect the inline testing requirements outlined in Directive 2010-03.

Applications currently submitted to the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) are being reviewed against the Directive criteria. New well applications will include the Directive requirements as a condition of approval should they meet both setback conditions.

REQUIREMENT:

The revised Manual and Form are now available via the Commission website at www.ogc.gov.bc.ca. There will be a two week transition period during which the previous submission Form will be accepted. Full implementation of both the Manual and new Form will be effective June 28, 2010.
